January 14-15, 2025 - Sending schools will be transporting students to North Hunterdon for a half day orientation program on the day that was designated for their school: January 14 (Bethlehem Township, Union Township, Franklin Township, non-public schools), January 15 (Clinton Township, Clinton Public School)

February 3-13, 2025 - North counselors will be available at North for optional appointments with students and their parents. If you would like to meet with a North counselor, please contact the Counseling Office at 713--4130 after winter break. There will be a limited number of slots, so please schedule early if you would like to take advantage of this opportunity to meet to discuss your child's course requests for next year.

March, 2025 – Course requests will be posted in Aspen for review. All errors must be reported to the counseling office by the end of April.
