Dear Parent or Guardian:

The transition process for your 8th-grade student will begin soon. To facilitate a smooth transition for your son or daughter to Voorhees High School, a calendar of 8th-grade scheduling activities has been planned. Please review the activities below and mark your calendars with these important dates.

January 1, 2025 Scheduling materials including the Course Selection Guide will be available.

January 9, 2025 8th grade Evening Orientation Program, for all our sending school parents, will begin at 6:30 p.m. in the Theater. Presentations will include an overview of high school life by administrative staff, in addition to information on the scheduling process.

January 8-9, 2025 - Sending schools will be transporting students to Voorhees for a half-day orientation program on the day that was designated for their school: January 8 (Lebanon Township, Clinton Public, Hampton, and non-public schools), January 9 (Tewksbury, Califon, and High Bridge)

February 3-14, 2025 Voorhees counselors will be available at Voorhees for optional appointments with students and their parents. If you would like to meet with a Voorhees counselor, please contact the Counseling Office at 638-2130 after winter break. There will be a limited number of slots, so please schedule early if you would like to take advantage of this opportunity to meet to discuss your child's course requests for next year.

March, 2025 - Course requests will be posted in Aspen for review. All errors must be reported to the Counseling Office by the end of April.

Enclosed is a copy of our registration form, which must be completed promptly and returned to your middle school counselor. They will forward the forms to Voorhees. Please note that it is very important to register your son or daughter using his or her full, legal first name. This will be the name that appears on the student's transcript, which is ultimately sent to the college and universities, so it is important to maintain consistency.

We hope this information is helpful to you. We look forward to working with you and to welcoming the class of 2029 to Voorhees High School.
